# Fall Housing Selection Reserve your room for Fall 2017 in 3 easy steps:



Pay a \$500 **non-refundable housing deposit** by noon on March 22 Deposits can be paid by check, cash, or credit card at the Center for Student Services or online through accessing *Student Accounts Suite* via MMC Connect.

\* Please make sure you do not have a balance on your student account, otherwise your \$500 deposit will be considered payment on your account, not your housing deposit.

#### **Lottery Information & How to Reserve Your Bed**

- After noon on March 22 any student who has submitted **BOTH** their housing application and deposit will have a lottery number generated for a two hour time slot. Students will be emailed their time slot later that week.
- Students who submit both an application and deposit after noon on March 22 and before noon on March 29 will get to choose their room on March 30, the last day of Fall Housing Selection. Students who submit their application and deposit after March 29 will have a space assigned to them after FHS, as space allows.

**Individual Sign-Up:** Arrive during your time slot on the assigned day, or have a proxy attend in your place. You can choose your room or let us match you with roommates. It is possible you may have roommates you do not know.

**Group Sign-Up:** If students want to go as a group they can pick the roommate with the earliest time slot. Everyone in the group **MUST** be present at the time of selection or designate a proxy to represent you. The proxy must have a Proxy Form for everyone in the suite not in attendance.

Proxy forms can be found online, in the RA Office, or in the Office of Residence Life in Carson 807.

## **Housing Fees & Dining Dollars**

#### **Housing Fees:**

\$6,995 per semester\* \$13,990 per year\* \$250 Damage Deposit

#### **Dining Dollars:**

A minimum of \$1,000 Dining Dollars per semester are required for all students who live on campus. You can select a larger amount of Dining Dollars on the housing application.

\*These are the 2016-17 rates. 2017-18 rates will be published as soon as approved by the Board of Trustees.

### **Important:**

- Continuing students will live at Cooper Square. There are limited spaces at the 55th
  Street Residence Hall in RA apartments. You can request to be on the waitlist on your
  application and on your Selection Day.
- Bed configurations cannot be adjusted which means lofted beds must remain lofted.
- Be sure you want to live in housing before you sign up. Once you complete the deposit
  and application, you will be liable for paying for housing for the entire academic year.
- You are strongly urged to obtain renters insurance, or verify coverage with your family's homeowners policy for theft, damage, loss, etc. of your personal belongings.

#### By electronically signing the Contract you are agreeing to:

- Reside in the residence halls for the entire academic year, and be responsible for all housing fees for the duration of the academic year, whether or not you drop to part-time.
- Abide by all policies in the Resident's Guide to Community Living.
