

Kurzweil 3000 Training Guide

Kurzweil is a software for students who have a reading or sensory disability. This software will take text or print and turns it into an Audio accessible document.

Kurzweil is found in the Thomas J Shanahan Library on the 3^{rd} Floor at the stand alone computer. Attached is scanner which Kurzweil can read from.

MMC also has a web access version of K3000, if you would like access to this please email lgreen@mmm.edu for the username and password.

To open K3000, click on the Shortcut on the top of the left hand corner of the computer.



Select new worksheet and begin:

K3000 has 3 different choices as a medium for reading.

- Read Mode: You can upload documents (Word Doc or PDF).
 Tools that can be used are highlighting, checklists and magnifiers.
- Write Mode: You can type into this mode and K3000 will read it as you type. This will be good for writing essays or for documents where you can to copy and paste.
 Tools that can be used are highlights, dictating, spell check and prediction text.
- Scan Mode: Any texts that are on print can be scanned into K3000 for playback.

All modes have a customizable task bar which can implement different tools for support. Voices and voice speeds can also be changed.
