Dear MMC Students, Faculty, and Staff:

I write to let you know that the College has launched the all-important reaccreditation process with the <u>Middle States Commission on Higher Education</u> ("Middle States"). Why do I use the superlative "all-important"? Because, in addition to demonstrating MMC's educational quality to the public and providing opportunities for institutional self-appraisal and continuous improvement, <u>Middle States accreditation makes MMC students eligible for federal financial aid</u>. For many, accreditation is the key to college affordability.

The two-year reaccreditation process is being guided by a Steering Committee co-chaired by Dr. Peter Naccarato, Interim Vice President for Academic Affairs/Dean of the Faculty, and Dr. Nava Silton, Associate Professor of Psychology, and including faculty, staff, and students.

This coming Monday—October 19, 2020—the College will host a virtual visit by our Middle States Liaison, Dr. Paul Starkey. I hope you will attend the open meeting from 10:00 to 11:00 AM at which Dr. Starkey will review the reaccreditation process and answer your questions. Dean Naccarato and Dr. Silton will send more details about this meeting shortly, including a Zoom link.
